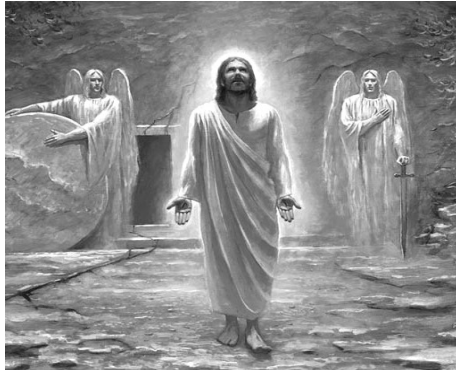

Did You Know?

Next week we celebrate the Octave of Easter. The Octave is ranked as the highest ranking liturgical feast of the Church’s calendar called a Solemnity. Our Lord’s Resurrection will continue in the Church for eight days following Easter.

Gospel readings at Masses during the Octave of Easter include passages from the Gospels that relate to various appearances of the Risen Jesus. Reflecting on these Gospel texts is a wonderful way to prolong the celebration of Easter.

As we celebrate the Sunday of Divine Mercy, may the Lord help us to spread his mercy and to bear witness to it among all our brothers and sisters!
